

Charity Search Engine and Suspended Charities List³⁰

The Secretary of State’s Office provides a Charity Search feature on its website that indicates whether a charity is registered to solicit in South Carolina, and provides financial data from the charity’s last annual financial report. The Secretary of State also provides a list of suspended charities that is updated daily.
