## A JOINT RESOLUTION

TO APPROPRIATE MONIES FROM THE CAPITAL RESERVE FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016, AND TO ALLOW UNEXPENDED FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO BE CARRIED FORWARD TO SUCCEEDING FISCAL YEARS AND EXPENDED FOR THE SAME PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina:

SECTION 1. 17 completion of the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year in accordance with the  
18 provisions of Section 36(B)(3)(a), Article III, Constitution of South  
19 Carolina, 1895, and Section 11-11-320(D)(1) of the 1976 Code.
