H*3717 (Rat #0431, Act #0395 of 1986) General Bill, By M.D. Burriss and T.F. Rogers

A Bill to amend Section 16-17-700, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to unlawful tattooing, so as to provide that it is not unlawful for a licensed physician or surgeon to tattoo part of patient's body if in his medical opinion it is necessary when performing cosmetic or reconstructive surgery.
