A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 16-11-110, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO ARSON, SO AS TO REVISE THE ELEMENTS OF ARSON IN THE FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD DEGREES, AND REVISE THE PENALTIES FOR ARSON IN THE FIRST AND SECOND DEGREES; TO AMEND SECTION 16-11-140, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE UNLAWFUL BURNING OF CROPS AND CERTAIN OTHER PROPERTY, SO AS TO REVISE THE TYPES OF PROPERTY THIS PROVISION APPLIES TO; TO AMEND SECTION 16-1-60, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO VIOLENT CRIMES, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ARSON IN THE SECOND DEGREE IS A VIOLENT CRIME; TO AMEND SECTION 17-25-45, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE IMPOSITION OF A LIFE SENTENCE FOR CERTAIN PERSONS CONVICTED THREE TIMES FOR CERTAIN CRIMES, SO AS TO INCLUDE ARSON IN THE SECOND AS A "SERIOUS OFFENSE"; AND BY ADDING SECTION 45-2-35 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN CANINES MUST BE PERMITTED TO STAY OVERNIGHT IN CERTAIN PLACES OR PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION, TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR PERSONS WHO VIOLATE THIS PROVISION, AND TO ALLOW AN INNKEEPER OF CERTAIN PLACES OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS TO DESIGNATE A SPECIFIC ROOM FOR USE BY CERTAIN CANINES.-AMENDED TITLE
