### **H\*3910 (Rat #0525, Act #0423 of 1982) General Bill, By House Medical, Military, Public and Municipal Affairs**

A Bill to amend Sections 44-53-190, 44-53-210, 44-53-230, and 44-53-250, all as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to controlled substances, so as to add Alphamethylfentanyl, Fenethylamine, and N-Ethylamphetamine to Schedule I, to include the generic name Meperidine opposite Pethidine in Schedule II, to move Mazindol from Schedule III to Schedule IV, and to add Alprazolam to Schedule IV.-at
