A Bill to amend Section 15-27-15, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to interpreters for the deaf in legal proceedings, so as to define "qualified interpreter" and "deaf person", to further define legal proceedings, to include deaf persons who are witnesses, to further provide for selection of interpreters, and to require interpretation understandable to the deaf person when confinement to an institution is an issue.-amended title
