AGENCY’S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

USC Salkehatchie is a dynamic regional campus serving the rural Lowcountry. The University is one of the anchors in the community and a key for future growth and prosperity in a region characterized by widespread poverty and a declining population. Despite challenges inherent to its region’s economic conditions, USC Salkehatchie successfully strives to meet ambitious goals. While anticipating the new USC Columbia and Palmetto College’s strategic plans, this report also contains many of the metrics from the last few years. USC Salkehatchie has continually sought excellence in **student population and success; faculty efforts in the classroom and in research; inclusion; affordability and accessibility; community partnerships; organizational/financial health; and athletic sportsmanship.**

FY 2022 was a challenging year as USC Salkehatchie experienced a decline in enrollment numbers. Enrollment challenges has been a factor that necessitated changes in executive leadership, reorganization of departments, and changes in reporting structure. Despite the challenges that affected performance metrics, USC Salkehatchie has continued to meet the needs of its students and its communities. With new leadership in place across various departments, the future of USC Salkehatchie appears promising and metrics are improving.

The Best Students/Affordability and Accessibility

During FY 2021 and FY 2022, USC Salkehatchie’s headcount and FTE declined, yet current numbers are indicative of movement in a positive direction. Visibility in the community, broader community engagement, and our social media presence contributed to an increase in applications

and interest in our campus. Our athletic programs received the Region X Sportsmanship Award recognizing no ejections of any USC Salkehatchie player for all sports. This upcoming year will include aggressive recruiting for our nursing program (in partnership with USC Beaufort) highlighting the Simulation Lab and for our criminal justice courses taught by active and retired law enforcement. The creation of an Early College program and a Salkehatchie Scholars honors program (in partnership with USCB) encourages motivated students to start their academic careers at USC Salkehatchie. Grant funding awarded by the Department of Energy and National Nuclear Security Administration, administered through Savannah River Site Community Reuse Organization (SRSCRO) has provided new scholarships for incoming STEM majors.

Enrollment growth is both a short-term and long-term focus for USC Salkehatchie, and the move toward a larger student body is balanced with a desire to recruit and retain students committed to learning. USC Salkehatchie serves as an alternate access point to higher education for students whose situations—whether economic, personal, or academic—will not allow them to begin immediately at a four-year campus. USC Salkehatchie’s tuition and required fees are tied with the other Palmetto College campuses as the lowest financial threshold to a university education in the state, and tuition and required fees were not raised in the last few years. At USC Salkehatchie’s 2023 Commencement, 79 Associate in Art or Associate in Science degrees were awarded to students. Furthermore, the expansion of academic offerings through Palmetto College is enabling Salkehatchie to serve more students locally and for longer. While some students pursue baccalaureate degrees at other institutions after completing the first two years of higher education at USC Salkehatchie, many others are now taking advantage of collaborative programs in nursing, education, and Palmetto College online classes, to complete the requirements for baccalaureate degrees without having to leave the Salkehatchie area. Commencement included the awarding of 23 baccalaureate degrees through its partnerships. USC Beaufort at USC Salkehatchie nursing graduates earned a 100% first-time NCLEX-RN pass rate. All of the above numbers represent students taking advantage of life-changing opportunities. The expansion of academic offerings is essential for the achievement of USC Salkehatchie’s mission as an institution of higher education. Indeed, USC Salkehatchie consistently strives to find new and innovative ways to fulfill students’ long-term educational goals and meet the educational needs of its communities. Many potential students in our service area are unable to attend classes in-person. USC Salkehatchie offers online associate degrees, giving the community another way to access higher education. USC Salkehatchie embraces USC’s Graduation with Leadership Distinction (GLD) and overall expansion of experiential-learning opportunities, as well as USC Salkehatchie’s long running efforts to form community and local-industry partnerships that facilitate and inspire student internship opportunities and career paths. In 2022, both the Allendale and Walterboro campuses of USC Salkehatchie opened Palmetto College iCarolina Community Learning Labs available to students, staff, faculty, and the public. FY 2023 plans include the completion of Student Commons Building in Walterboro, which will house classrooms, a weight room, and spaces that will also be available to the public.

World-Class Faculty/Staff and Outstanding Research

USC Salkehatchie continues to emphasize faculty excellence by striving to offer competitive salaries, providing opportunities for greater intellectual challenge through the teaching of upper-level courses in Palmetto College, providing support for engagement in scholarship and research, and by encouraging involvement in campus and local-community service. The greater University has shown support by making internal grant opportunities available to Palmetto College

campuses faculty (as well as students for undergraduate research), and USC Salkehatchie faculty has responded by regularly winning these grant awards, including ASPIRE, RISE, and PROPEL, thereby enhancing their scholarly production/expertise in their fields. Faculty mentor students most notably through GLD research projects, Magellan grants, and summer PURE grants. Overall, USC Salkehatchie faculty has been highly successful with scholarly production and grants. Two faculty members received tenure and promotion to Associate Professor and in 2022, USC Salkehatchie faculty traveled internationally 7 times to present research and to 23 regional or national conferences. Faculty produced 7 creative works including two documentaries, artwork, and commissioned exhibit panels.

Accessibility and Inclusion

USC Salkehatchie strives to attract faculty, staff, and students from a variety of backgrounds through a welcoming, inclusive, and encouraging campus culture. Currently, our student population is 43% minority (31% African American). Fifty-five percent of the student population is non-traditional and 85% of the study body is from South Carolina. Within the United States, students are from Alabama, Arizona, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, New York, Tennessee, Utah, and Virginia. Three percent of our enrolled students are international students, further enriching our campus environment. Most are athletes and are from Jamaica, Brazil, Australia, Germany, Chili, England, Sweden, and Trinidad and Tobago. Additionally, six (28%) full-time faculty members were born outside the United States.

Community Partnerships and Excellent Infrastructure

Educational attainment is the cornerstone of USC Salkehatchie’s mission, but community outreach efforts demonstrate the institution's creativity in meeting local needs. The Salkehatchie Leadership Institute, the community-outreach arm of the university, assists municipalities and community groups with economic development and other projects that strike directly at the quality of life experienced by the residents of the region. Among its many efforts, the Institute sponsors a Take Flight! Aviation Camp for 8th graders from Allendale and Colleton Counties, partnering with The Boeing Company, the local chapter of the Tuskegee Airmen, Joint Base Charleston, and local school districts. The Institute provides a yearlong advanced leadership program, Leadership Salkehatchie, for civic leaders residing in the six counties of Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Colleton, Hampton, and Jasper, sponsored by a local economic development partner, SouthernCarolina Alliance. The Institute was instrumental in renovations made to the historic Carolina Theatre, accomplished in part through a USDA Rural Development grant, completed in 2013. Since that time, the theater has proved an important space for use by theater classes and has hosted numerous cultural and university events.

Additionally, USC Salkehatchie was selected as a partner in an initiative by Savannah River Nuclear Solutions and the Department of Energy for Workforce Opportunities in Regional Careers grants (WORC I and WORC II). Through this partnership we have been able to focus our efforts on strengthening regional workforce pipeline development and promoting STEM career opportunities available through USC Salkehatchie, including our Associate of Science, the 2+2 Industrial Process Engineering program with USC Aiken, and the Computer Science program (with an emphasis on Cybersecurity) through Palmetto College, while providing support to students through free peer tutoring, scholarships, individualized internships, experiential

learning, and mentoring. This partnership and its impacts extend beyond current USC Salkehatchie students, to K-12 students and community members throughout the service area. Hands-on STEM outreach events, led by our STEM Coordinator with support from current Salkehatchie STEM student ambassadors, expose and motivate participants, while simultaneously increasing awareness of the possibilities available regionally.

In 2022, the iCarolina Learning Labs opened on both campuses. The labs have offered community classes, university classes for students and the community, and iCarolina Kids Camps this summer.

In Allendale, the Carolina Theatre has been actively used by community groups in the past year and the Salkehatchie Hut should open as a community space in late 2023.

Within greater USC’s “Experience by Design” quality enhancement program (administered by the Center for Integrative and Experiential Learning), USC Salkehatchie continues to support faculty members who involve students in internships, independent research, and other modalities of experiential learning. USC Salkehatchie seeks to increase the number of students involved in service learning and Graduation with Leadership Distinction (GLD) honors. USC Salkehatchie continues to provide campus activities and programs that are designed to enrich the experience of its students and enhance its communities.

To ensure institutional strength, stability, and excellence, USC Salkehatchie is consistently involved not only in systemwide planning, but also in its own long-range planning, work that

traditionally occurs in the Dean’s Cabinet meetings especially during the planning retreats. The new campus dean has reinstated planning sessions for both short-and long-range planning including maintaining a 3 months’ operating budget in reserve; improvements to Allendale and Walterboro facilities, including a long-range plan for renovations that will add useful space to the Walterboro campus; and the shuttering and planned demolition of Allendale facilities deemed financial and insurance liabilities. USC Salkehatchie consistently revisits and enhances institutional planning processes, using assessment methods for continual improvement in administrative support services, including business office operations, physical plant and maintenance, and university development.

Risk Assessment and Mitigation Strategies

USC Salkehatchie participates in the USC Enterprise Risk Management Program (ERM), which was established with the guidance of International Standards Organization, ensuring that any and all forms of risk are managed in a systematic, transparent, and credible manner. Risk is routinely considered in long- and short-term institutional planning. USC Salkehatchie is the primary higher education institute in Allendale County and Colleton County, along with our other service areas (Bamberg, Barnwell, and Hampton Counties), and failing to accomplish our goals and objectives would negatively impact the statewide enterprise objective to elevate the level of educational preparedness of South Carolinians.

Overall Analysis

USC Salkehatchie continues to have a tremendous impact on its five-county service area, statewide, and beyond. Through participation in, and adherence to, the flagship campus’ and

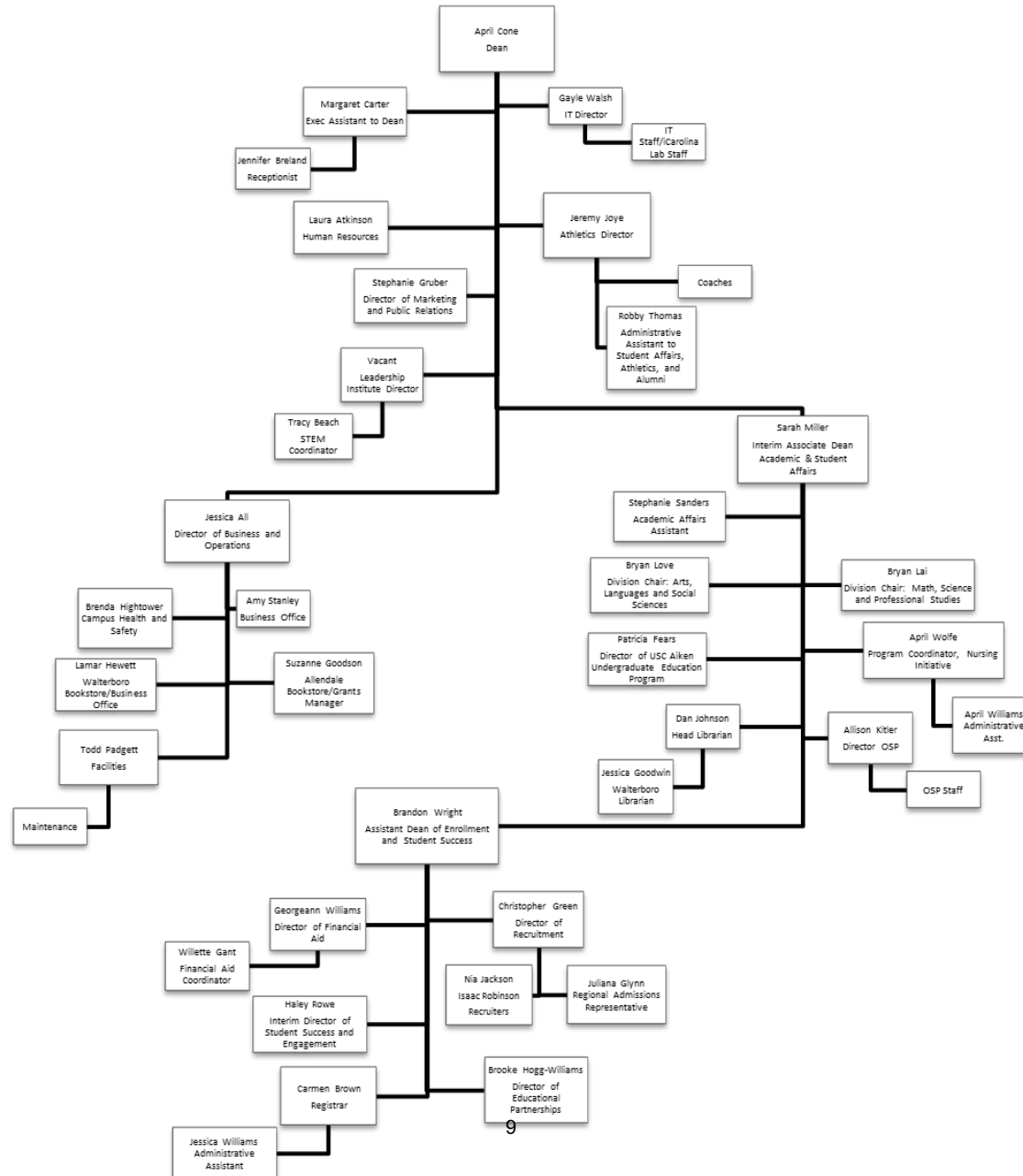

The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus is a branch campus of the University of South Carolina Columbia. Salkehatchie has as its mission to provide higher education and intellectual leadership for its service area. At the heart of this mission is a teaching faculty of high quality dedicated to excellence in instruction, scholarship, public and professional service and creative endeavor which enrich the classroom experience. The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus offers a varied curriculum grounded in the liberal arts and focused on preparing students to continue their education in the University of South Carolina System and throughout life.

The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus recruits students prepared to succeed in completing a baccalaureate-level education. While the institution does not offer remedial instruction, it is nonetheless able to admit most students who apply due to the close working relationship between students and faculty. The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus was established to encourage higher education in the counties of Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Colleton and Hampton. The original design of the institution incorporated a flexibility that has allowed changes in institutional capability with increasing educational demands of constituents.

Through classroom and laboratory instruction delivered in a variety of face-to-face and distance learning formats and modalities, the institution awards the Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees and provides for the completion of selected bachelor's degrees on campus through cooperative agreements and delivery structures with other University of South Carolina System institutions. The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus also provides general education and upper division coursework applicable to baccalaureate degree programs offered through colleges and universities nationwide. In addition to academic coursework, the mission of the campus includes noncredit courses, seminars, and workshops made available to the community for cultural enrichment and professional development.

The traditions of cultural diversity and freedom of thought are valued at the Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus. In a learning environment that develops respect for racial, geographical, intellectual, and economic diversity and an awareness of individual, societal, and global responsibilities, Salkehatchie promotes courses, activities, and attitudes which influence the life of the mind in men and women and instill in them a thirst to continue learning throughout life.

The Salkehatchie regional Palmetto College campus emphasizes the development of the whole person and especially seeks to foster in students the disciplines essential to an educated citizenry.
