**State Expenditure**

This bill amends Section 8-13-1314 relating the campaign contributions that prohibits candidates from accepting campaign contributions from a noncandidate committee directly or indirectly related to a candidate or public official. The bill amends Section 8-13-1340 relating to the restrictions on contributions by one candidate to another and committees related to a candidate

The State Ethics Commission indicates that this bill would require changes to the electronic filing system. The expenditure impact would be minimal and can be absorbed within current resources.
