**Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill would increase Other Fund expenditures by \$2,365,284 in FY 2016-17 and a recurring \$260,884 each following year. This bill would have no expenditure impact on the General Fund or Federal Funds.

**Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

**State Expenditure**

This bill amends Section 10-1-220 to place free feminine hygiene products in each female restroom in every public building, agency, office, department, division, commission, or institution owned by the State.

**Department of Administration.** The department indicates this bill would require nonrecurring Other Fund expenditures of \$2,365,284 in FY 2016-17 to purchase, install, and supply 2,965 feminine hygiene product dispensers. A dispenser costs \$550 to purchase, \$150 for installation, and \$87 in supplies for an average total of \$787 each. Annual recurring Other Fund expenditures will be \$260,884 for sanitary pads and tampon supplies. Costs for feminine hygiene product dispensers and supplies were based on current state contracts, and the number of dispensers was based on a one-per-floor requirement assumption for state buildings. This bill would have no expenditure impact on the General Fund or Federal Funds.
