This bill adds Article 8 to Title 62 so as to enact the South Carolina Uniform Power of Attorney Act. Finally, the bill amends Article 5, Title 62 so as to enact the South Carolina Statutory Health Care Power of Attorney Act and to define applicable terms and outline requirements and applicability.
