Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill provides a two-year extension for high school diploma petitions for those individuals who previously failed to receive a high school diploma or was denied graduation for failing to meet the exit exam requirements.

The State Department of Education indicates it would spend about \$9,500 a year in public outreach efforts to promote the law each fiscal year. The department would be able to absorb those costs within existing appropriations.
