The director of the Department of Insurance or his designee is authorized to issue bulletins, regulations, or orders, as necessary, to implement the provision of this bill. If any bulletins, regulations, or orders are needed, the department would issue them in the normal course of business and according to its ordinary procedures. Otherwise, the bill does not fiscally or operationally impact the Department of Insurance. Therefore, the bill has no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
