Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on February 14, 2018 State Expenditure

This bill provides that the state interest should prevail if a conflict exists between the exercise of power by a regional health services district and the antitrust laws of either the state or the United States. Each regional health services district is governed by a board of directors. This bill creates no additional duties for these boards, nor does it alter the oversight or regulatory duties of DHEC. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
