## **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill gives the Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) the authority to promulgate regulations regarding, make decisions about the permitting of, and conduct inspections and investigations of facilities of waste tire management. There is no fiscal impact to the department because it will accomplish the duties enumerated in the bill with its existing appropriations and staff.

## **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

## **Introduced on January 12, 2021 State Expenditure**

This bill authorizes DHEC to promulgate regulations to protect human health and environmental safety from the adverse effects of improper, inadequate, or unsound management of waste tires. Additionally, the department may issue, deny, suspend, revoke, or modify permits for the management of waste tires and may conduct inspections and investigations of any waste tire management facility. The agency reports that it will accomplish the duties enumerated in the bill with its existing appropriations and staff. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact to DHEC.
