Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill allows the secretary of the Coastal Carolina University (CCU) board of trustees to send required notice of any meeting time and place to each trustee either by mail or electronically. Currently, meeting notices must be mailed to each trustee.

This bill will have no fiscal impact on CCU, as any potential savings on postage for the four required meetings will be minimal.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on February 8, 2022

State Expenditure

This bill allows the secretary of the CCU board of trustees to send required notice of any meeting time and place to each trustee either by mail or electronically. Currently, meeting notices must be mailed to each trustee. While there could be minimal savings for postage if meeting notices for the four required meetings are sent electronically, instead of being mailed, there will be no significant reduction in expenses. Therefore, CCU indicates that this bill will have no fiscal impact on the agency.
